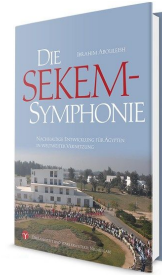

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Clothing

To be able to choose the right set of clothes you should consider both the climate and the cultural peculiarities. Egypt can get colder in winter than you might expect. During daytime temperatures will be around 25°C and below 10°C in the night. So make sure to pack something warm. Furthermore, in accordance to egyptian culture you should always cover your shoulders, back and stomach and avoid very figure-accentuating clothes in general. These rules apply more to women than to men. Nonetheless men shouldn't be wearing shorts or other clothes that show much skin either. As we intend to do some physical work on the farm, please bring some working clothes and sturdy shoes.

One of our program points includes drawing and writing. So if you have your own material that you would like to use, bring it with you. All the rest is taken care of.

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As entry requirements can vary for different countries please check if the following information are applying to you.

For the entry into Egypt your passport should be valid at least six months longer than you are planning to stay.

You can get your tourist visa upon arrival at the Cairo airport. It is available for the amount of 25 dollars or the equivalent in euros and must be paid in either one of these currencies. You will find the bank counter that sells the visas on the right side in front of the passport control. The visa is valid for 30 days and can be extended once you are here.



For further information and to avoid inconveniences due to sudden changes in entry regulations please take a look at the website of your Foreign Office.

Please make sure that we get your flight details so that we can arrange a driver for you. After finishing the immigration process you just have to walk out of the airport and you won't be able to miss the wooden sign saying SEKEM in welcoming orange letters. One hour later you will finally arrive at the farm.

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You can either pay in advance per bank transfer or pay in cash in the guest-house after your arrival. The guest house accepts Euros, Dollars and EGP. Please note that the guest house is not taking credit cards.
